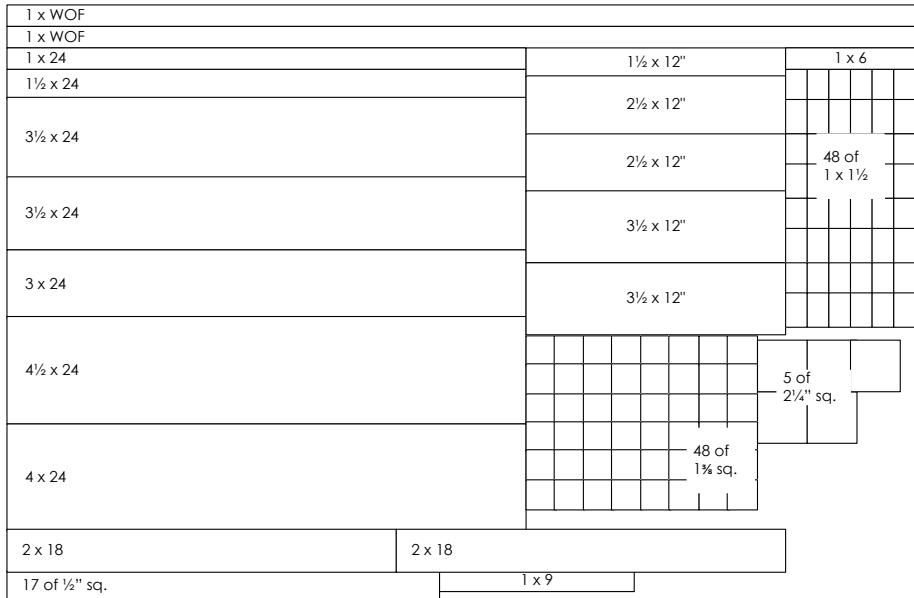

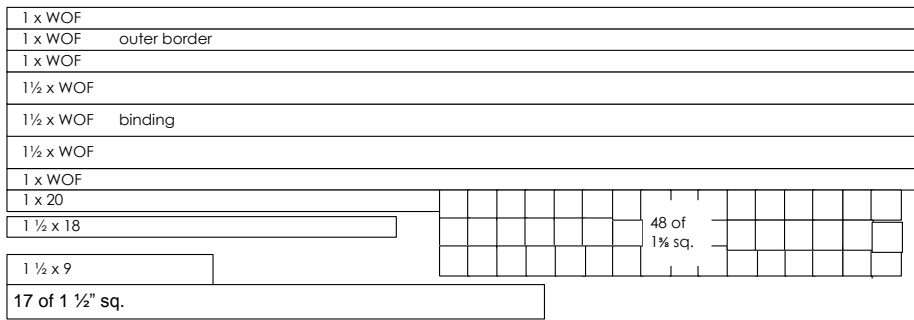

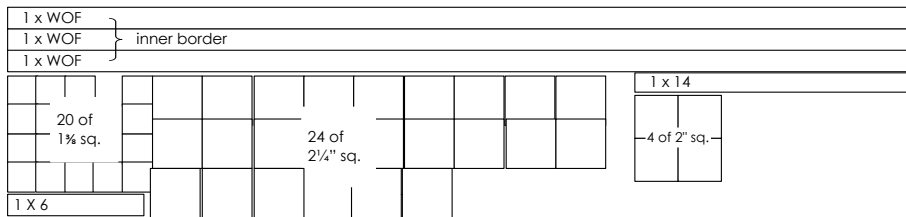
4" blocks – background fabric **MINIMUM** requirement: 26" (66 cm) x WOF



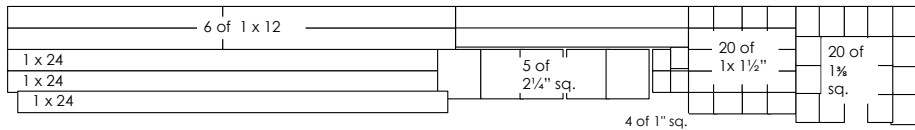
4" blocks – focus fabric **MINIMUM** requirement: 13.5" (35 cm) x WOF



4" blocks – dark fabric **MINIMUM** requirement: 10" (25 cm) x WOF



4" blocks – medium fabric **MINIMUM** requirement: 5.5" (15 cm) x WOF  
 Note: if you're using a FQ, you can cut the 1 x 24's in 2 pieces.





## Step 3: Start your engines !!

## 4" Blocks

The very first sewing we do will be to get the slowest and most labor intensive part over with first.

Find the indicated pieces in column 1 and make the required number of flying geese.

The shortcut to flying geese is on the next page.

## 4" Blocks

Using the pieces indicated, strip-piece together and follow directions in table.
