

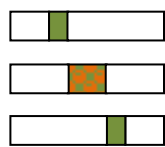
## Step 9

This time you're making 12 blocks.

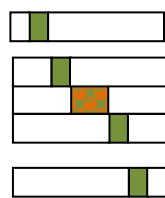
Find all the resulting pieces from step 6 and

12 pieces  from step 4

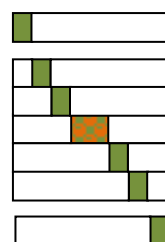
Sew into blocks as follows:



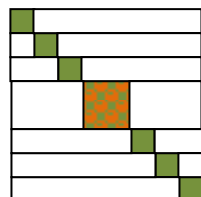
} These two pieces are the same, but one is flipped

You now have 12 of these blocks


## Step 10

Another set of 12 blocks

From step 7 collect 48  and from step 4 collect 48 

You should (besides border pieces) still have some cut pieces that you haven't done anything with yet:

 You have 17 squares in focus fabric, you'll need 12 for this step and 5 for step 11 (4" block: 1½" sq., 8" block: 2½" sq. and 10" block: 3" sq.)

 You have strips of background fabric left

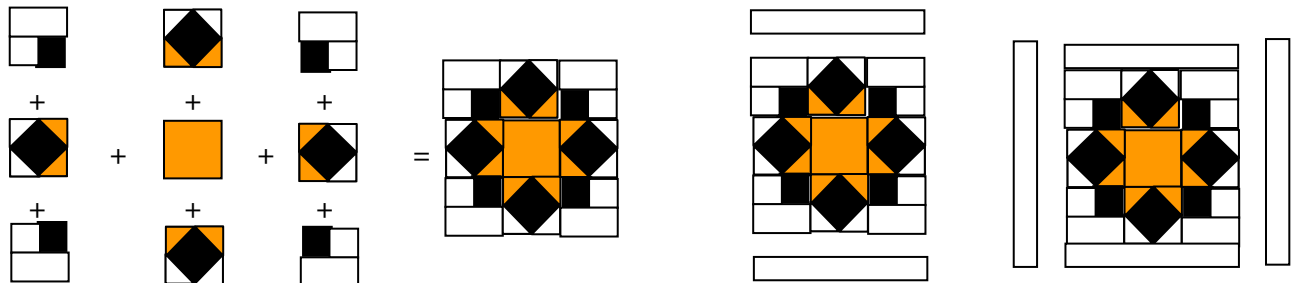
**4" block:** 1 strip of 3½ x 24 and 1 strip of 4 x 24 → cut both strips into 1" slices

**8" block:** 1 strip of 6½ x 36 and 1 strip of 8½ x 36 → cut both strips into 1½" slices

**10" block:** 1 strip of 8 x WOF and 1 strip of 10½ x WOF → cut both into 1¾" slices




You will have 24 slices of 2 different lengths.

Now assemble 12 blocks:



## Step 11

Just 5 more blocks !!!

From step 7 collect 20  and 20  as well as the last 5  squares you still have.

Assemble 5 blocks as follows:
